We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

Dates: Sunday, August 2 to Sunday, August 17, 2020

Location: The alley behind 5800-5900 N. Winthrop Avenue

Work Hours: Continuous Daytime and Nighttime Work

Work Activity: Interlocking Installation

Local Impact:

- The alley will be closed (24/7) until the work activity is completed.
- Vehicles will be unable to enter/exit garages and parking spaces.

- There will be noise while work is being performed at track and street level from July 17 – August 17. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Running air compressors and generators
 - Use of pneumatic and gas/impact tools
 - Metal on metal material handling
 - Noise from rail equipment, crane and maintenance equipment
 - Beeping for backup alarms on maintenance equipment and vehicles
 - Flagging horn
