We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

Location:

- W. Balmoral Avenue between the CTA tracks and N. Winthrop Avenue
- The alley behind 5352 – 5358 N. Winthrop Avenue & 1109 – 1111 W. Balmoral Avenue

Work Hours: 7am-7pm, **continuous, 24/7 street closure**

Work Activity: Drilled Shaft Installation

Local Impact:

- W. Balmoral Avenue between the CTA tracks and N. Winthrop Avenue will be closed to vehicular traffic.
- Sidewalk closures will alternate between the north and south sides of W. Balmoral Avenue.
- One sidewalk will remain open at all times.
- Residents south of W. Balmoral Avenue will need to access the alley via W. Berwyn Avenue.
- **Vehicles will be unable to enter/exit the parking spaces at 5352 – 5358 N. Winthrop Avenue and 1109 – 1111 W. Balmoral Avenue.**
- The contractor will provide alternative parking for impacted residents.
- If you need further information about alternative parking, please contact the contractor, Walsh-Fluor, at 708-253-9772.
- The contractor will maintain garbage and recycling pickup.
- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Noise and vibration from drilling and hauling material
 - Beeping from backup alarms on maintenance equipment and vehicles
 - Flagging horns
