We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

EXTENDED ALLEY CLOSURE

- Dates:** Weekdays & Saturdays
Monday, November 11 to Saturday, December 7, 2024
- Location:** The alley west of 4700 – 4752 N. Winthrop Avenue
(W. Leland Avenue to W. Lawrence Avenue)
- Work Hours:** 7am to 7pm; continuous 24/7 alley closure
- Work Activity:** Alley Reconstruction
- Local Impact:**
- The alley will be closed at all times.
 - Vehicles will be unable to enter/exit garages and parking spaces in the alley between W. Leland Avenue and W. Lawrence Avenue on the east side of the CTA Tracks during this closure.
 - ***For your safety, please do not attempt to use the alley for any purpose unless in an emergency situation.***
 - Contractor will provide alternative parking for residents with dedicated private parking accessed via the alleyway. If you need further information about alternative parking, please contact the contractor, Walsh-Fluor, at cpoole@walshgroup.com.
 - Garbage and recycling bins will be relocated to N. Winthrop Avenue by the contractor until the work activity is complete. Please dispose of garbage and recycling in your relocated bins located on N. Winthrop Avenue until the alley is reopened and the contractor has moved bins back.
 - Access to the parking lot at 1114 W. Leland Avenue (The Clover Building Condominiums) & garage at 4750 N. Winthrop Avenue (The Winnie Uptown Apartments) will be maintained via the entrances/exits located on N. Winthrop Avenue.
 - There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - **Loud noise from pavement demolition**
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
