

# Construction Activity Notice

We are performing work in preparation for extending the Red Line by 5.5 miles from the 95<sup>th</sup> Street Terminal to 130<sup>th</sup> Street. The Red Line Extension also includes building four new Red Line stations at 103<sup>rd</sup>, 111<sup>th</sup>, Michigan (near 116<sup>th</sup>) and 130<sup>th</sup> streets. To build the project, work will be performed that may affect your community. While progress sometimes comes with inconveniences, we will do our best to keep them to a minimum.

**Dates:** **Friday, June 26, 2026**  
*Dates are subject to change due to weather and construction schedule adjustments.*

**Locations:** S. Michigan Avenue from E. Kensington Avenue to E. 116<sup>th</sup> Street

**Work Hours:** **7am to 10am**

**Work Activity:** Construction Equipment Relocation

**Local Impact:**

- **S. Michigan Avenue will be closed from E. Kensington Avenue to E. 116<sup>th</sup> Street.**
- Flagger assistance will be on site to guide traffic around the street closure.
- E. Kensington Avenue will be open to traffic.
- There will be sidewalk closures while the work is being performed.
- Only one sidewalk will be closed at a time.
- All closures will be removed immediately once the relocation has been completed.
- There will be noise while the work is being performed. Noise will include:
  - General construction noise
  - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
  - Flagging horns
