We are performing work in preparation for extending the Red Line by 5.5 miles from the 95th Street Terminal to 130th Street. The Red Line Extension also includes building four new Red Line stations at 103rd, 111th, Michigan (near 116th) and 130th streets. To build the project, work will be performed that may affect your community. While progress sometimes comes with inconveniences, we will do our best to keep them to a minimum.

Locations: W. 115th Street from S. State Street to S. Perry Avenue

Work Hours: 7am to 11am

Work Activity: Construction Equipment Relocation

Local Impact:

- **W. 115th Street will be closed from S. State Street to S. Perry Avenue.**
- There will be sidewalk closures while the work is being performed.
- Flagger assistance will be on site to guide traffic around the closures.
- The street will reopen immediately after the relocation is complete.
- There will be noise while the work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
 - Flagging horns
