

Construction Activity Notice

We are performing work in preparation for extending the Red Line by 5.5 miles from the 95th Street Terminal to 130th Street. The Red Line Extension also includes building four new Red Line stations at 103rd, 111th, Michigan (near 116th) and 130th streets. To build the project, work will be performed that may affect your community. While progress sometimes comes with inconveniences, we will do our best to keep them to a minimum.

NEW DATES **4-HOUR STREET CLOSURE**

Dates: **Thursday, August 13 to Friday, August 14, 2026**
*(Note: Work will only take place on **one** of these days. Dates are subject to change due to weather and construction schedule adjustments.)*

Locations: 351 W. 109th Street to the Union Pacific Railroads (UPRR) Tracks

Work Hours: **7am to 11am**

Work Activity: Construction Equipment Relocation

Local Impact:

- **W. 109th Street will be closed from 351 W. 109 Street to the UPRR tracks.**
- Flagger assistance will be on site to guide traffic around the street closure.
- There will be sidewalk closures while the work is being performed.
- Only one sidewalk will be closed at a time.
- All closures will be removed immediately once the relocation has been completed.
- There will be noise while the work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
 - Flagger horns
