

Construction Activity Notice

CTA is performing utility relocation work ahead of breaking ground on the new Red Line Extension (RLE) in 2026. RLE will extend the Red Line by 5.5 miles from the 95th Street Terminal to 130th Street and include construction of four new stations at 103rd Street, 111th Street, Michigan Avenue and 130th Street. The work includes relocating utility poles and other equipment located where the new tracks will be built. Work will be performed that may affect your community and we will do our best to keep impacts to a minimum.

Locations: 11603 to 11633 S. Indiana Avenue

Work Hours: 9am to 3pm, daily

Work Activity: ComEd & AT&T Cable Pulling

Local Impact:

- ComEd & AT&T will be performing work in the alley adjacent to 11633 S. Indiana Avenue.
- Vehicles will be prohibited from entering/exiting the alley via S. Indiana Avenue while work is being performed.
- Vehicles will need to enter/exit the alley via S. Prairie Avenue.
- The closure will be removed at the end of each workday.
- There will be noise while the work is being performed. Noise may include:
 - General construction noise
 - Noise from truck engine
 - Saw cutting for excavation
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
