

Construction Activity Notice

CTA is performing utility relocation work ahead of breaking ground on the new Red Line Extension (RLE) in 2026. RLE will extend the Red Line by 5.5 miles from the 95th Street Terminal to 130th Street and include construction of four new stations at 103rd Street, 111th Street, Michigan Avenue and 130th Street. The work includes relocating utility poles and other equipment located where the new tracks will be built. Work will be performed that may affect your community and we will do our best to keep impacts to a minimum.

Locations: In the alleys and roadways near the following locations:

- W. 103rd Street and S. Eggleston Avenue
- W. 110th Place to W. 113th Place and S. Princeton Avenue

- W. 115th Street and S. LaFayette Avenue
- E. 116th Street and S. Michigan Avenue
- E. 117th Street and S. Prairie Avenue

Work Hours: 7am to 7pm

Work Activity: Pole Removal & Overhead Utility Work

Local Impact:

- **There will be intermittent parking lane and partial alley closures within the work zones.**
- There will be noise while the work is being performed. Noise may include:
 - General construction noise
 - Saw cutting
 - Truck Traffic
 - Noise from truck engine
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
