Including but not limited to: <ul> <li>Helmet</li> <li>Gloves</li> <li>Structural firefighting gear including boots</li> <li>Eye protection</li> <li>Hearing Protection</li> <li>Respiratory Protection</li> </ul> </li> <li>No excessive water or flooding will occur</li> <li>No live fire will occur on properties once demolition begins</li> <li>There will be noise while training is being performed. Noise will include: <ul> <li>Engine noise</li> <li>Use of gas operated powered tools for saw cutting</li> <li>CFD radio and personnel communication</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
