

# Construction Activity Notice

We are performing work in preparation for extending the Red Line by 5.5 miles from the 95<sup>th</sup> Street Terminal to 130<sup>th</sup> Street. The Red Line Extension also includes building four new Red Line stations at 103<sup>rd</sup>, 111<sup>th</sup>, Michigan (near 116<sup>th</sup>) and 130<sup>th</sup> streets. To build the project, work will be performed that may affect your community. While progress sometimes comes with inconveniences, we will do our best to keep them to a minimum.

- The alley behind 401 to 413 W. 103<sup>rd</sup> Street
- The alley behind 343 to 351 W. 108<sup>th</sup> Place
- The alley behind 347 to 351 W. 109<sup>th</sup> Street
- 349 to 361 W. 110<sup>th</sup> Street
- 343 W. 111<sup>th</sup> Street
- The alley behind 337 to 345 W. 111<sup>th</sup> Place
- 11332 S. Princeton Avenue

**Work Hours:** 7am to 5pm, weekdays

**Work Activity:** ComEd Tree Removal

**Local Impact:**

- ComEd crews will work from south to north.
- **There will be intermittent parking lane and alley closures within the work zone with flagger assistance.**
- Access to the alley and garages will be maintained.
- No closures will be put in place until work begins at each location.
- The contractor will implement the necessary dust mitigation procedures if needed.
- There will be noise while the work is being performed. Noise may include:
  - Use of chainsaws
  - Noise from a wood chipper and stump remover
  - Beeping from back-up alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
