

Construction Activity Notice

We are performing work in preparation for extending the Red Line by 5.5 miles from the 95th Street Terminal to 130th Street. The Red Line Extension also includes building four new Red Line stations at 103rd, 111th, Michigan (near 116th) and 130th streets. To build the project, work will be performed that may affect your community. While progress sometimes comes with inconveniences, we will do our best to keep them to a minimum.

Work Activity: Building Demolition & Environmental Abatement

Local Impact:

- Partial sidewalk and street closures may occur in the work zone while work is being performed.
- **The alley behind 133 to 135 W. 114th Street: Closed continuously for the duration of the project.**
- **Remainder of the alley: Closed during active work hours only and reopened at the end of each workday.**
- Crews will be performing targeted environmental abatement activities while demolishing designated buildings within the above addresses. Crews will be using the following tools during the abatement:
 - Fence and building containment
 - A specialized vacuum
 - Air/Environmental monitoring equipment
- Crews will implement the necessary procedures to mitigate dust and will collect, remove, and dispose of all abated materials pursuant to the Illinois EPA and Chicago Department of Public Health guidelines.
- There will be noise while the work is being performed. Noise may include:
 - General demolition noise
 - Running of air compressors, excavators, and generators
 - Use of pneumatic and gas impact tools
 - Truck traffic
 - Beeping from back-up alarms on demolition equipment and vehicles
