

# Construction Activity Notice

We are performing work in preparation for extending the Red Line by 5.5 miles from the 95<sup>th</sup> Street Terminal to 130<sup>th</sup> Street. The Red Line Extension also includes building four new Red Line stations at 103<sup>rd</sup>, 111<sup>th</sup>, Michigan (near 116<sup>th</sup>) and 130<sup>th</sup> streets. To build the project, work will be performed that may affect your community. While progress sometimes comes with inconveniences, we will do our best to keep them to a minimum.

**Work Activity:** Building Demolition & Soil Remediation

**Local Impact:**

- Partial sidewalk and street closures may occur in the work zone while work is being performed.
- **The alley behind 133 to 135 W. 114<sup>th</sup> Street: Closed continuously for the duration of the project.**
- Crews will be performing targeted building demolition activities and soil remediation operations. Demolition debris and contaminated soil will be collected, transported, and disposed of at approved facilities in accordance with applicable environmental regulations.
- Crews will implement the necessary procedures to mitigate dust.
- There will be noise while the work is being performed. Noise may include:
  - General demolition noise
  - Running of air compressors, excavators, and generators
  - Use of pneumatic and gas impact tools
  - Truck traffic
  - Beeping from back-up alarms on demolition equipment and vehicles
