

Construction Activity Notice

We are performing work in preparation for extending the Red Line by 5.5 miles from the 95th Street Terminal to 130th Street, including construction of four new Red Line stations at 103rd, 111th, Michigan (near 116th) and 130th streets. To build the project, work will be performed that may affect your community. While progress sometimes comes with inconveniences, we will do our best to keep them to a minimum.

Weekdays & Saturdays

Dates: **Monday, July 13 to Tuesday, December 1, 2026**

Dates are subject to change due to weather & construction schedule adjustments

Locations: Along the future path of the Red Line track between 99th Place and 108th Street

Work Hours: 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Work Activity: Building new track foundations & columns

Local Impact:

- This is a rolling construction operation. Crews will first perform drilled shaft installation, immediately followed by track column installation as they move through the work zone.
- Construction will begin near S. Princeton Avenue and W. 108th Street and proceed north toward W. 99th Place.
- The contractor will maintain garbage and recycling pickup.
- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Noise and vibration from drilling and hauling material
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
 - Flagger horns
- There may be dust while work is being performed; the contractor will implement the necessary procedures to mitigate it.
- Additional Construction Activity Notices with detailed information about public way impacts will be provided as work progresses.
