

Construction Activity Notice

We are performing work in preparation for extending the Red Line by 5.5 miles from the 95th Street Terminal to 130th Street. The Red Line Extension also includes building four new Red Line stations at 103rd, 111th, Michigan (near 116th) and 130th streets. To build the project, work will be performed that may affect your community. While progress sometimes comes with inconveniences, we will do our best to keep them to a minimum.

DAILY SIDEWALK & TRAFFIC LANE CLOSURES

Dates: **Thursday, May 28 to Monday, Wednesday, June 3, 2026**
Dates are subject to change due to weather & construction schedule adjustments

Locations: 140 E. 116th to the Union Pacific Railroad Tracks

Work Hours: 7am to 5pm, weekdays

Work Activity: Building New Track Foundations & Columns

Local Impact:

- **The sidewalk on the north side of the street from 140 E. 116th Street to the UPRR tracks will be closed while the work is being performed.**
- **The sidewalk on the south side of the street from 151 to 155 E. 116th Street will be closed while the work is being performed.**
- Only one sidewalk will be closed at a time.
- **The north-bound traffic lane on S. Prairie Avenue from 154 E. 116th Street to the UPRR tracks will be closed while the work is being performed.**
- A single lane of traffic on the south side of the street will remain open with flagger assistance.
- All closures will be removed at the end of each workday.
- There will be noise while the work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Noise and vibration from drilling and hauling material
 - Beeping from backup alarms on maintenance equipment and vehicles
 - Flagger horns
- The contractor will implement the necessary dust mitigations throughout the project.
