

Construction Activity Notice

We are performing work in preparation for extending the Red Line by 5.5 miles from the 95th Street Terminal to 130th Street. The Red Line Extension also includes building four new Red Line stations at 103rd, 111th, Michigan (near 116th) and 130th streets. To build the project, work will be performed that may affect your community. While progress sometimes comes with inconveniences, we will do our best to keep them to a minimum.

Locations: 11630 to 11636 S. Prairie Avenue

Work Hours: 7am to 5pm, daily

Work Activity: Building New Track Foundations & Columns

Local Impact:

- The sidewalk on the west side of the street within the work zone will be closed while the work is being performed.
- The sidewalk on the east side of S. Prairie Avenue will remain open at all times.
- Flaggers will be on-site to assist as needed.
- The sidewalk closure will be removed at the end of each workday.
- There will be noise while the work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Noise and vibration from drilling and hauling material
 - Beeping from backup alarms on maintenance equipment and vehicles
 - Flagging horns
- The contractor will implement the necessary dust mitigations throughout the project.
