We are performing work in preparation for extending the Red Line by 5.5 miles from the 95th Street Terminal to 130th Street. The Red Line Extension also includes building four new Red Line stations at 103rd, 111th, Michigan (near 116th) and 130th streets. To build the project, work will be performed that may affect your community. While progress sometimes comes with inconveniences, we will do our best to keep them to a minimum.

Dates are subject to change due to weather & construction schedule adjustments

Locations: W. 115th Street from S. Lafayette Avenue to S. Perry Avenue

Work Hours: 7am to 7pm, weekdays & Saturdays

Work Activity: Building New Track Foundations & Columns

Local Impact:

- **The south sidewalk on W. 115th Street will be closed from S. Lafayette Avenue to S. Perry Avenue while the work is being performed.**
- The north sidewalk will remain open at all times.
- There will be noise while the work is being performed. Noise may include:
 - General construction noise
 - Noise and vibration from drilling and hauling material
 - Beeping from back-up alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
 - Flagging horns
- There may be dust while work is being performed; the contractor will implement the necessary procedures to mitigate it.
