

# Construction Activity Notice

We are performing work in preparation for extending the Red Line by 5.5 miles from the 95<sup>th</sup> Street Terminal to 130<sup>th</sup> Street. The Red Line Extension also includes building four new Red Line stations at 103<sup>rd</sup>, 111<sup>th</sup>, Michigan (near 116<sup>th</sup>) and 130<sup>th</sup> streets. To build the project, work will be performed that may affect your community. While progress sometimes comes with inconveniences, we will do our best to keep them to a minimum.

## WEEKEND & WEEKDAY EXTENDED SIDEWALK CLOSURES

**Dates:**

- **Saturday, June 13 to Wednesday, June 17, 2026**
- **Wednesday, July 8 to Tuesday, July 14, 2026**

**Locations:** The east & west sidewalks on S. Michigan Avenue from E. Kensington Avenue to the Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) tracks

**Work Hours:** 7am to 5pm, weekends & weekdays

**Work Activity:** Building New Track Foundations & Columns

**Local Impact:**

- **June 13 to June 17:** The east sidewalk on S. Michigan Avenue will be closed from E. Kensington Avenue to the UPRR tracks
- **July 8 to July 14:** The west sidewalk on S. Michigan Avenue will be closed from E. Kensington Avenue to the UPRR tracks
- Only one sidewalk will be closed at a time. The opposite sidewalk will remain open.
- There will be noise while the work is being performed. Noise will include:
  - General construction noise
  - Noise and vibration from drilling and hauling material
  - Beeping from backup alarms on maintenance equipment and vehicles
  - Flagging horns
- The contractor will implement the necessary dust mitigations throughout the project.
