

Construction Activity Notice

We are performing work in preparation for extending the Red Line by 5.5 miles from the 95th Street Terminal to 130th Street. The Red Line Extension also includes building four new Red Line stations at 103rd, 111th, Michigan (near 116th) and 130th streets. To build the project, work will be performed that may affect your community. While progress sometimes comes with inconveniences, we will do our best to keep them to a minimum.

UPDATED DATES **INTERMITTENT PARKING LANE CLOSURES**

Dates: **Monday, August 24 to Friday, September 4, 2026**
(Dates are subject to change due to weather and construction schedule adjustments)

Locations: Near TCA Health Center's east parking lot entrance to the railroad crossing

Work Hours: **7am to 5pm, weekdays**

Work Activity: Asphalt Pavement Restoration

Local Impact:

- **There will be intermittent parking lane closures within the work zone with flagger assistance.**
- No closures will be put in place until work begins at that location.
- Closures will be removed at the end of each workday.
- There will be noise while the work is being performed. Noise may include:
 - General construction noise
 - Equipment noise from machinery and running air compressors
 - Use of pneumatic tools
- Beeping from back-up alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
- The contractor will implement the necessary dust mitigations throughout the project.
