

Construction Activity Notice

We are performing work in preparation for extending the Red Line by 5.5 miles from the 95th Street Terminal to 130th Street. The Red Line Extension also includes building four new Red Line stations at 103rd, 111th, Michigan (near 116th) and 130th streets. To build the project, work will be performed that may affect your community. While progress sometimes comes with inconveniences, we will do our best to keep them to a minimum.

Locations: W. 111th Place between S. Princeton Avenue and the Union Pacific Railroad Tracks

Work Activity: Asphalt Pavement Restoration

Local Impact:

- There will be traffic lane shifts within the work zone, with flagger assistance while the work is being performed.
- There will be noise while the work is being performed. Noise may include:
 - General construction noise
 - Equipment noise from machinery and running air compressors
 - Use of pneumatic tools
- Beeping from back-up alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
- There will be dust while the work activity is being performed, and the contractor will implement the necessary procedures to mitigate the dust.
