

Construction Activity Notice

We are performing work in preparation for extending the Red Line by 5.5 miles from the 95th Street Terminal to 130th Street. The Red Line Extension also includes building four new Red Line stations at 103rd, 111th, Michigan (near 116th) and 130th streets. To build the project, work will be performed that may affect your community. While progress sometimes comes with inconveniences, we will do our best to keep them to a minimum.

PERMANENT CLOSURES

Effective Date: Wednesday, June 3, 2026

Locations:

- W. 105th Street to W. 104th Street, from S. Eggleston Avenue to the Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) tracks
- W. 103rd Street from S. Normal Avenue to the UPRR tracks

Work Hours: 7am to 5pm (Crews on-site)
Closure Duration: Permanent, continuous 24/7

Work Activity: Permanent Street, Sidewalk, & Alley Closures

Local Impact:

- W. 105th Street will be permanently closed from 413 W. 106th Street to the UPRR tracks.
- W. 104th Street will be permanently closed from 408 W. 104th Street to the UPRR tracks.
- W. 103rd Place, including the north sidewalk, will be permanently closed from 412 W. 103rd Place to the UPRR tracks.
- The north-south alley west of the UPRR tracks will be permanently closed from W. 103rd Place to W. 103rd Street.
- The east-west alley between 409 W. 103rd Street and 410 W. 103rd Place to the UPRR tracks will be permanently closed.
- A temporary alley will be installed at 418 W. 103rd Place prior to construction.
