

## Construction Activity Notice

We are performing work in preparation for extending the Red Line by 5.5 miles from the 95<sup>th</sup> Street Terminal to 130<sup>th</sup> Street. The Red Line Extension also includes building four new Red Line stations at 103<sup>rd</sup>, 111<sup>th</sup>, Michigan (near 116<sup>th</sup>) and 130<sup>th</sup> streets. To build the project, work will be performed that may affect your community. While progress sometimes comes with inconveniences, we will do our best to keep them to a minimum.

Work Hours: 7am to 5pm, daily

Work Activity: Locating Underground Utilities & Pavement Restoration

**Local Impact:** 

- The parking lane within the work zone on the south side of W. 103<sup>rd</sup> Street will be closed while the work is being performed.
- The parking lane closure will be removed at the end of each workday.
- There will be noise while the work is being performed. Noise may include:
  - General construction noise
  - Equipment noise from jackhammers and running air compressors
  - Use of pneumatic tools
  - Beeping from back-up alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
- There will be dust while the work activity is being performed, and the contractor will implement the necessary procedures to mitigate the dust.
