

Construction Activity Notice

We are performing work in preparation for extending the Red Line by 5.5 miles from the 95th Street Terminal to 130th Street. The Red Line Extension also includes building four new Red Line stations at 103rd, 111th, Michigan (near 116th) and 130th streets. To build the project, work will be performed that may affect your community. While progress sometimes comes with inconveniences, we will do our best to keep them to a minimum.

DAILY PARKING & TRAFFIC LANE IMPACTS

- 408 W. 111th Street (*No anticipated impacts*)
- 11553 - 11563 S. Michigan Avenue
- 13053 - 13055 S. Greenwood Avenue

Work Hours: **7am to 5pm, daily**

Work Activity: Locating Underground Utilities & Pavement Restoration

Local Impact:

- Crews will be working from north to south.
- No closures will be put in place until work begins at that location.
- **Eggleston Avenue:** There will be traffic lane closures within the work zone on the east side of the street.
- **111th St, Michigan Ave, & Greenwood Ave:** There will be parking lane closures within the work zone while the work is being performed.
- Flaggers will be on-site to assist with traffic flow around the work zones as needed.
- All closures will be removed at the end of each workday.
- There may be dust while the work activity is being performed, and the contractor will implement the necessary procedures to mitigate the dust.
- There will be noise while the work is being performed. Noise may include:
 - General construction noise
 - Equipment noise from jack hammers and running air compressors
 - Use of pneumatic tools
- Beeping from back-up alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
