We are performing work in preparation for extending the Red Line by 5.5 miles from the 95th Street Terminal to 130th Street. The Red Line Extension also includes building four new Red Line stations at 103rd, 111th, Michigan (near 116th) and 130th streets. To build the project, work will be performed that may affect your community. While progress sometimes comes with inconveniences, we will do our best to keep them to a minimum.

UPDATED DATES ALLEY & PARKING LANE IMPACTS

Dates: **Friday, March 13 to Friday, April 24, 2026**
(Dates are subject to change due to weather and construction schedule adjustments)

Locations: W. 109th Street at the following locations:
- The alley north of 334 to 342 W. 109th Street
- W. 109th Street just south of 10901 S. Eggleston Avenue
- 335 to 341 W. 109th Street

Work Hours: **7am to 5pm, weekdays**

Work Activity: Sewer Inspection

Local Impact:

- **There will be intermittent alley and parking lane closures within the work zone with flagger assistance.**
- No closures will be put in place until work begins at that location.
- The contractor will maintain garbage pickup.
- There will be noise while the work is being performed. Noise may include:
 - General construction noise
 - Equipment noise from inspection trucks and running air compressors
 - Use of pneumatic tools
 - Beeping from back-up alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
