

Construction Activity Notice

We are performing work in preparation for extending the Red Line by 5.5 miles from the 95th Street Terminal to 130th Street. The Red Line Extension also includes building four new Red Line stations at 103rd, 111th, Michigan (near 116th) and 130th streets. To build the project, work will be performed that may affect your community. While progress sometimes comes with inconveniences, we will do our best to keep them to a minimum.

Work Activity: Site Preparation

Local Impact:

- Site preparation work will include:
 - Site inspection
 - Utilities inspection & disconnection
 - Abatement (Asbestos, lead, & rodent abatement)
- There will be noise while the work is being performed. Noise may include:
 - General construction noise
 - Running of air compressors, excavators, and generators
 - Use of pneumatic and gas impact tools
 - Beeping from back-up alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
- The contractor will implement necessary dust mitigations and will use specialized equipment to monitor air quality, noise, and vibration
