

Construction Activity Notice

We are performing work in preparation for extending the Red Line by 5.5 miles from the 95th Street Terminal to 130th Street. The Red Line Extension also includes building four new Red Line stations at 103rd, 111th, Michigan (near 116th) and 130th streets. To build the project, work will be performed that may affect your community. While progress sometimes comes with inconveniences, we will do our best to keep them to a minimum.

UPDATED DATES **SIDEWALK CLOSURES**

Dates: **Friday, August 14 to Monday, August 31, 2026**
Dates are subject to change due to weather & construction schedule adjustments

Locations: 140 E. 116th to the Union Pacific Railroad Tracks

Work Hours: 7am to 5pm, daily

Work Activity: Track Column Concrete Pour

Local Impact:

- Sidewalk closures will alternate between the north and south side of E. 116th Street while the work is being performed.
- **The north sidewalk will be closed from 140 E. 116th Street to the UPRR tracks.**
- **The south sidewalk will be closed from 151 to 155 E. 116th Street.**
- Only one sidewalk will be closed at a time.
- There will be noise while the work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Beeping from backup alarms on maintenance equipment and vehicles
 - Flagging horns
- The contractor will implement the necessary dust mitigations throughout the project.
