

# Construction Activity Notice

We are performing work in preparation for extending the Red Line by 5.5 miles from the 95<sup>th</sup> Street Terminal to 130<sup>th</sup> Street. The Red Line Extension also includes building four new Red Line stations at 103<sup>rd</sup>, 111<sup>th</sup>, Michigan (near 116<sup>th</sup>) and 130<sup>th</sup> streets. To build the project, work will be performed that may affect your community. While progress sometimes comes with inconveniences, we will do our best to keep them to a minimum.

## **UPDATED DATES** **SIDEWALK CLOSURES**

**Dates:** **Monday, August 31 to Friday, September 4, 2026**  
*Dates are subject to change due to weather & construction schedule adjustments*

**Locations:** 140 E. 116<sup>th</sup> to the Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) Tracks

**Work Hours:** 7am to 7pm, weekday & Saturdays

**Work Activity:** Track Column Concrete Pour

**Local Impact:**

- Sidewalk closures will alternate between the north and south side of E. 116<sup>th</sup> Street while the work is being performed.
- **The north sidewalk will be closed from 140 E. 116<sup>th</sup> Street to the UPRR tracks.**
- **The south sidewalk will be closed from 151 to 155 E. 116<sup>th</sup> Street.**
- Only one sidewalk will be closed at a time.
- There will be noise while the work is being performed. Noise will include:
  - General construction noise
  - Beeping from backup alarms on maintenance equipment and vehicles
  - Flagging horns
- The contractor will implement the necessary dust mitigations throughout the project.
