

# Construction Activity Notice

We are performing work in preparation for extending the Red Line by 5.5 miles from the 95<sup>th</sup> Street Terminal to 130<sup>th</sup> Street. The Red Line Extension also includes building four new Red Line stations at 103<sup>rd</sup>, 111<sup>th</sup>, Michigan (near 116<sup>th</sup>) and 130<sup>th</sup> streets. To build the project, work will be performed that may affect your community. While progress sometimes comes with inconveniences, we will do our best to keep them to a minimum.

**Dates:** **Friday, August 7 to Friday, August 14, 2026**  
*(Dates are subject to change due to weather and construction schedule adjustments)*

**Locations:** 11563 S. Michigan Avenue to the Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) Tracks

**Work Hours:** **7am to 5pm, daily**

**Work Activity:** Track Column Concrete Pour

**Local Impact:**

- **The east sidewalk will be closed from 11563 S. Michigan Avenue to the UPRR tracks while the work is being performed.**
- The west sidewalk will remain open at all times..
- There will be noise while the work is being performed. Noise will include:
  - General construction noise
  - Beeping from backup alarms on maintenance equipment and vehicles
  - Flagging horns
- The contractor will implement the necessary dust mitigations throughout the project.
