

# Construction Activity Notice

We are performing work in preparation for extending the Red Line by 5.5 miles from the 95<sup>th</sup> Street Terminal to 130<sup>th</sup> Street. The Red Line Extension also includes building four new Red Line stations at 103<sup>rd</sup>, 111<sup>th</sup>, Michigan (near 116<sup>th</sup>) and 130<sup>th</sup> streets. To build the project, work will be performed that may affect your community. While progress sometimes comes with inconveniences, we will do our best to keep them to a minimum.

**Dates:** **Wednesday, June 17 to Friday, June 26, 2026**  
*(Dates are subject to change due to weather and construction schedule adjustments)*

**Locations:** 410 W. 107th Street

**Work Hours:** 7am to 5pm, daily

**Work Activity:** Underground Storage Tank Removal

**Local Impact:**

- There will be noise while the work is being performed. Noise may include:
  - General construction noise
  - Noise and vibrations from excavators, air compressors, and vacuum trucks.
  - Beeping from back-up alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
- The contractor will implement the necessary procedures to mitigate dust, and will excavate, remove, and dispose of the old underground storage tank in accordance with the City of Chicago and Illinois EPA regulations.
