We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

EXTENDED STREET CLOSURE

Date(s): Monday, December 5 to Monday, December 12, 2022

Location: W. Cornelia Avenue, between the CTA tracks and N. Wilton Avenue

Work Hours: 7am-7pm, continuous, 24/7 street closure

Work Activity: Lead Abatement & Painting

Local Impact:

- W. Cornelia Avenue between the CTA tracks and N. Wilton Avenue will be closed to vehicular traffic.
- The sidewalk on the north side of W. Cornelia Avenue will be closed until the work activity is complete.
- The sidewalk on the south side of W. Cornelia Avenue will be open at all times.
- Crews will abate and paint the CTA structure, using the following tools, some of which will produce noise:
 - Containment covers
 - Portable generator & air compressor
 - Blast equipment & power tools
 - A specialized vacuum
 - Environmental monitoring equipment
- Crews will collect paint chips, debris and dust and dispose pursuant to Illinois EPA Guidelines for Hazardous Waste.
