

# Construction Activity Notice

We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

**Dates:** **Friday, April 29 to Monday, May 2, 2022**  
*Dates are subject to change due to weather and construction schedule adjustments*

**Location:**

- W. Newport Avenue, between N. Clark Street and the CTA Tracks
- 800-810 W. Newport Avenue

**Work Hours:** 7am to 7pm; **continuous 24/7 sidewalk & street closure**

**Work Activity:** Drilled Shaft Installation

**Local Impact:**

- W. Newport Avenue from N. Clark Street to just east of the CTA tracks will be closed to vehicular traffic.
- The sidewalk on the north side of W. Newport Avenue within the work zone, underneath the CTA tracks will be closed until the work activity is completed.
- The sidewalk on the south side of W. Newport Avenue will remain open with flagger assistance when necessary.
- Access to the alleys near the CTA tracks via W. Newport Avenue will be prohibited.
- There will be no parking on the north side of W. Newport Avenue, from 800-810 W. Newport.
- **W. Newport Avenue will be TWO-WAY from N. Halsted Street to the first alley just west of N. Halsted Street.**
- **W. Newport Avenue will remain ONE-WAY east from the CTA tracks to the alley just west of N. Halsted Street.**
- There will be noise while work is being performed, including:
  - General construction noise
  - Noise and vibration from drilling and hauling material
  - Beeping from backup alarms on maintenance equipment and vehicles
  - Flagging horns
