- The parking lane on the north side of W. Newport Avenue within the work zone will be closed continuously (24/7) until the work activity is completed.
 - The sidewalk on the north side of W. Newport Avenue within the work zone will be closed until the work activity is completed.
 - The sidewalk on the south side of W. Newport Avenue will remain open at all times.
 - The alley entrance north of W. Newport Avenue will be blocked, but access will remain from W. Cornelia Avenue.
 - There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Noise from excavation, pile driving, and pouring
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
