

Construction Activity Notice

We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

Dates: Monday, January 18 to Friday, January 29, 2021

Location: N. Sheffield Avenue, between N. Clark Street & W. Roscoe Street

Work Hours: 7am to 7pm; weekdays; continuous 24/7 street and sidewalk closure

Work Activity: Bypass Steel Erection

Local Impact:

- N. Sheffield Avenue, between N. Clark Street & W. Roscoe Street will be closed to vehicular and bicyclist traffic.
- Westbound access to W. Roscoe Street from N. Sheffield Avenue will be maintained.
- The sidewalk on the west side of N. Sheffield Avenue will be closed
- The sidewalk on the east side of N. Sheffield Avenue will remain open.
- The contractor will maintain access to businesses and residences.
- The contractor will maintain garbage pick-up and access for deliveries.
- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Noise from crane lifting and setting
 - Beeping for backup alarms on maintenance equipment and vehicles
 - Flagging Horns
