We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

Dates: Monday, January 4 to Friday, April 30, 2021

Location: The alley behind of 3221-3351 N. Sheffield Avenue

Work Hours: 7am to 7pm; Continuous 24/7 alley closure.

Work Activity: Temporary Track Foundation Work

Local Impact:

- The alley will be closed to through traffic at all times.
- Vehicles will be unable to enter/exit garages and parking spaces via the alley during this closure.
- If it is possible for the contractor to reopen sections of the alley for a period of time, residents will be notified.
- If you have not received information about alternative parking and temporary parking passes, please contact the contractor, Walsh-Fluor, at 312-971-7797.
- The contractor will maintain garbage and recycling pick up
- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Noise and vibration from driving sheet pile
 - Noise from drilling, pouring, and loading
 - Beeping for backup alarms on equipment and vehicles
