

# Construction Activity Notice

We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

**Dates:** Tuesday, June 8 to Thursday, June 10, 2021 (*Daily Closure*)  
Friday, June 11 to Friday, July 30, 2021 (*Extended Closure*)

**Location:** The alley behind of 3221-3259 N. Sheffield Avenue

**Work Hours:** 7am to 7pm, weekdays, with potential weekend work  
Continuous 24/7 alley closure

**Work Activity:** Temporary Track Steel Erection

**Local Impact:** June 8 to June 10, 2021

- Daily blockages in the alley will occur during stated work hours, but access to garages/parking spaces will be maintained.
- The alley will be closed to through traffic at all times.

June 11 to July 30, 2021

- Vehicle access to enter/exit garages and parking spaces via the alley will be restricted until the work activity is completed.
- The alley will be closed to through traffic at all times.
- If it is possible for the contractor to reopen sections of the alley for a period of time, residents will be notified.
- If you have not received information about alternative parking and temporary parking passes, please contact the contractor, Walsh-Fluor, at 312-971-7797.
- The contractor will maintain garbage and recycling pick up
- There will be noise while work is being performed, including:
  - General construction noise
  - Noise from crane lifting and setting
  - Beeping for backup alarms on maintenance equipment and vehicles
  - Flagger Horns
