We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

Dates: Thursday, July 1 to Friday, September 3, 2021

Location: The alley behind of 3301-3351 N. Sheffield Avenue

Work Hours: 7am to 7pm, weekdays & potential weekends
Continuous 24/7 alley closure

Work Activity: Temporary Track Foundation Work and Steel Erection

Local Impact:

- The alley will be closed to through traffic at all times.
- Vehicle access to enter/exit garages and parking spaces will be restricted during closure.
- If it is possible for the contractor to reopen sections of the alley for a period of time, residents will be notified.
- If you have not received information about alternative parking, please contact the contractor, Walsh-Fluor, at 708-253-9772.
- The contractor will maintain garbage and recycling pick up.
- There will be noise while work is being performed, including:
 - General construction noise
 - Noise from crane lifting and setting.
 - Beeping for backup alarms on maintenance equipment and vehicles.
 - Flagger Horns.
