### PARKING LANE & SIDEWALK IMPACTS

**Dates:** **Wednesday, October 25 to Friday, November 3, 2023**

**Location:** W. Cornelia Avenue underneath the CTA Tracks

**Work Hours:** **7am to 7pm; weekdays & Saturdays**

**Work Activity:** Track Work

**Local Impact:**

- There will be lane shifts on W. Cornelia Avenue with flagger assistance.
- The parking lanes on W. Cornelia Avenue within the work zone will be closed continuously (24/7) until the work activity is completed.
- Sidewalk closures within the work zone will alternate between the north and south sides of W. Cornelia Avenue
- One sidewalk will remain open at all times.
- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
  - General construction noise
  - Beeping for backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
  - Flagging horns
