NEW END DATE EXTENDED STREET CLOSURE

Dates: Monday, March 25 to Thursday, March 28, 2024

Location: W. School Street from the CTA Tracks to N. Wilton Avenue

Work Hours: 6pm to 4am; Overnight work with continuous 24/7 street closure

Beam Erection **Work Activity:**

Local Impact:

- W. School Street between the CTA Tracks and N. Wilton Avenue will be closed to vehicular and bicycle traffic.
- There will be intermittent traffic stops with flagger assistance on W. School Street between N. Wilton Avenue and N. Clark Street during beam delivery and lifting.
- The street closure will be set-up at 7am Monday morning and will be taken down by 6pm Thursday.
- The parking lanes on both sides of W. School Street between the CTA Tracks and N. Clark Street will be closed continuously (24/7) until the work activity is complete.
- The parking lanes on both sides of N. Wilton Avenue from W. School Street south to the alley entrance will be closed continuously (24/7) until the work activity is complete due to safety concerns.
- The sidewalk on the north side of W. School Street will be closed until the work activity is
- The sidewalk on the south side of W. School Street will remain open with intermittent closures during crane lifts due to safety concerns.
- N. Wilton Avenue will be northbound only between W. School Street and W. Belmont Avenue.
- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Noise from crane lifts and setting material
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
 - Flagging horns
 - There will be light in the work area
