

# Construction Activity Notice

We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

## Weekdays and Weekends

**Dates:** **Wednesday, September 8 to Tuesday, September 21, 2021**

**Location:** The alleys behind the following addresses will be closed:

- 1002 – 1042 W. Roscoe Street
- 1015 – 1043 W. Newport Avenue
- 3400 – 3420 N. Sheffield Avenue
- 3401 – 3425 N. Seminary Avenue

**Work Hours:**

- **Weekdays – 7am to 7pm**
- **Weekends – 10pm-Friday to 4am-Monday (Continuous around the clock work)**

**Work Activity:** Interlocking Installation

**Local Impact:**

- The alley will continue to be closed to through traffic at all times.
- Vehicles will be unable to enter/exit garages and parking spaces in the alley between Roscoe St and Newport Ave during this closure.
- Vehicle access to enter/exit garages and parking spaces in the alley west of Sheffield Avenue (except for 3406 N. Sheffield) and east of Seminary Avenue will be maintained during this closure.
- If you need further information about alternative parking, please contact the contractor, Walsh-Fluor, at 708-253-9772.
- The contractor will maintain garbage and recycling pick up.
- There will be noise while work is being performed, **including nighttime noise on weekends**. Noise will include:
  - General construction noise
  - Running air compressors and generators
  - Use of pneumatic and gas/impact tools
  - Metal on metal material handling
  - Noise from rail equipment, crane and maintenance equipment
  - Beeping for backup alarms on maintenance equipment and vehicles
  - Flagging horns
