**Work Hours:** **10pm, Friday to 10pm, Saturday (Continuous around the clock work)  
7am, Sunday to 12am, Monday**

**Work Activity:** Track Level Structure Rehabilitation

**Local Impact:**

- The alley will continue to be closed to through traffic at all times.
- The contractor will maintain garbage and recycling pick up.
- ***There will be no work Memorial Day weekend, the contractor will open the alley at the end of the workday on Friday, May 28<sup>th</sup> and the alley will remain open until 7am Tuesday, June 1<sup>st</sup>.***
- There will be noise while work is being performed.
- Daytime Noise:
  - Use of rivet removal equipment to remove old structural rivets
  - Running air compressors and generators.
  - Use of pneumatic and gas/impact tools.
  - Beeping from backup alarms on maintenance equipment and vehicles.
- Overnight Noise:
  - Minimal noise from torching and removing bolts and screws.
  - Beeping from backup alarms on manlifts.
