Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. - 3401 – 3425 N. Seminary Avenue

**Work Hours:** 7am – 7pm weekdays; no weekend work is anticipated at this time. The alley will be closed at all times.

**Work Activity:** Micropile Drilling and Installation

**Local Impact:**

- The alleys will be closed to through traffic at all times.
- Vehicles will be unable to enter/exit garages and parking spaces in the alley behind Roscoe Street and Newport Avenue during this closure.
- Vehicle access to enter/exit garages and parking spaces in the alley west of Sheffield Avenue (except for 3406 N. Sheffield) and east of Seminary Avenue will be maintained during this closure.
