Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. DAILY STREET CLOSURES

Date(s): Friday, September 13 to Friday, October 4, 2024

Location: W. Cornelia Avenue between N. Sheffield Avenue and N. Wilton Avenue.

Work Hours: 7am to 5pm

Work Activity: Trackwork

Local Impact:

- W. Cornelia Avenue between N. Sheffield Avenue and N. Wilton Avenue will be closed to vehicular and bicycle traffic during stated work hours.
- Local traffic will be permitted between the CTA Tracks and N. Sheffield Avenue as the work activity allows.
- Sidewalk closures within the work zone will alternate between the north and south sides of W. Cornelia Avenue.
- One sidewalk will remain open at all times.
- The alley entrance north of W. Cornelia Avenue will be blocked, but access will remain from W. Addison Street at all times.
- **W. Cornelia Avenue will not be closed on Cubs home day games.**
- There will be noise while work is being performed, including:
 - General construction noise
 - Noise from lifting and setting equipment and material
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction vehicles and equipment
 - Flagger horns
