We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

Dates: Monday, March 10 to Wednesday March 12, 2025

Location: W. School Street between N. Sheffield Avenue and N. Wilton Avenue

Work Hours: 9am to 5pm

Work Activity: Crane Staging & Lifts

Local Impact:

- On Monday, March 10, W. School Street between the CTA Tracks and N. Wilton Avenue will be closed to vehicular traffic only during stated work hours.
- On Tuesday, March 11, there will be a lane shift on W. School Street between N. Sheffield Avenue and N. Wilton Avenue during stated work hours.
- On Wednesday, March 12, W. School Street between the CTA Tracks and N. Wilton Avenue will be closed to vehicular traffic between 12pm and 4pm only.
- **Access to the alley and garage behind 918 W. School Street will be maintained via access from N. Clark Street with flagger assistance to W. School Street during daily closure hours.**
- Sidewalk closures will alternate between the north and south side of W. School Street at the CTA Tracks.
- One sidewalk will remain open at all times with flagger assistance when necessary.
- N. Wilton Avenue between W. Belmont Avenue and W. School Street will remain southbound during these impacts.
- There will be noise while work is being performed, including:
 - General construction noise
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
 - Flagger horns
