Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. Monday, March 10, 2025 (Tuesday, March 11 as backup date)

Location: W. School Street between the CTA Tracks and N. Wilton Avenue

Work Hours: **9am to 5pm**

Work Activity: Crane Staging & Rail Hoisting

Local Impact:

- W. School Street between the CTA Tracks and N. Wilton Avenue will be closed to vehicular traffic only during stated work hours.
- **Access to the alley and garage behind 918 W. School Street will be maintained via access from N. Clark Street with flagger assistance to W. School Street.**
- Sidewalk closures will alternate between the north and south side of W. School Street at the CTA Tracks.
- One sidewalk will remain open at all times with flagger assistance when necessary.
- N. Wilton Avenue between W. Belmont Avenue and W. School Street will remain southbound during stated work hours.
- There will be noise while work is being performed, including:
 - General construction noise
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
 - Flagging horns
