We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

EXTENDED STREET CLOSURE

Dates: Wednesday, February 26 to Thursday, March 27, 2025

Location:

- N. Sheffield Avenue from N. Clark Street/W. Newport Avenue to approx. 75ft south of W. Roscoe Street
- W. Roscoe Street from N. Clark Street to 1004 W. Roscoe Street

Work Hours: 7am – 7pm, **continuous 24/7 street closure**

Work Activity: Street & Sewer Reconstruction

Local Impact:

- N. Sheffield Avenue between N. Clark Street/W. Newport Avenue to approx. 75ft south of W. Roscoe Street will be closed to vehicular traffic.
- W. Roscoe Street between N. Clark Street and 1004 W. Roscoe Street will be closed to vehicular and traffic.
- Sidewalks on the east and west sides of N. Sheffield Avenue will be open.
- The sidewalk on the north side of W. Roscoe Street between N. Clark Street and N. Sheffield Avenue will be closed until the work activity is complete.
- The sidewalk on the north side of W. Roscoe Street west of N. Sheffield Avenue will remain open at all times.
- The sidewalk on the south side of W. Roscoe Street will remain open at all times.
- **N. Kenmore Avenue will be NORTHBOUND between W. Roscoe Street and W. School Street for the duration of this activity.**
- The contractor will maintain access to businesses and residences.
- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - Running air compressors and generators
 - **Loud noise from roadway demolition**
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
