EXTENDED SIDEWALK & PARKING LANE CLOSURE WITH LANE SHIFT

Dates: Weekdays/Weekend & Overnight

Location: - N. Sheffield Avenue from N. Clark Street/W. Newport Avenue to 3251 N. Sheffield Avenue

- W. Roscoe Street from N. Clark Street to 1004 W. Roscoe Street

Work Hours: 7am-Monday, Feb. 10 to 7am-Monday, Feb. 17

Work Activity: Track Structure Rehabilitation

Local Impact:

- The sidewalk on the west side of N. Sheffield Avenue from W. Roscoe Street north under the CTA Tracks will be closed until the work activity is complete.
- Access to the crosswalk on the west side of N. Sheffield Avenue to cross W.
 Roscoe Street will be maintained at all times.
- The parking lane on the west side of N. Sheffield Avenue from N. Clark Street/W. Newport Avenue south to 3251 N. Sheffield Avenue will be closed at all times.
- The parking lane on the north side of W. Roscoe Street from N. Clark Street west to 1004 W. Roscoe Street will be closed at all times.
- There will be traffic lane shifts on N. Sheffield Avenue and W. Roscoe Street around the work zone.
- Access to businesses and residences will be maintained at all times.
- There will be noise while work is being performed, including nighttime noise:
 - o General construction noise
 - Running air compressors and generators
 - Use of loud pneumatic and gas/impact tools
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
