

Construction Activity Notice

We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

EXTENDED ALLEY CLOSURE

Date(s): Weekdays and Weekends
Monday, April 18 to Saturday, December 31, 2022
Dates are subject to change due to weather and construction schedule adjustments

Location: The alleys behind the following addresses will be closed:

- 1002 – 1042 W. Roscoe Street
- 1015 – 1043 W. Newport Avenue
- 3400 – 3420 N. Sheffield Avenue
- 3401 – 3425 N. Seminary Avenue

Work Hours: 7am – 7pm; **continuous, 24/7 alley closure**

Work Activity: Track Structure Foundation Rehabilitation

Local Impact:

- The alleys will be closed to through traffic at all times.
- Vehicles will be unable to enter/exit garages and parking spaces in the alley between W. Roscoe Street and W. Newport Avenue during this closure.
- Vehicle access to enter/exit garages and parking spaces in the alley west of N. Sheffield Avenue (except for 3406 N. Sheffield) and east of N. Seminary Avenue will be maintained during this closure
- If you need further information about alternative parking, please contact the contractor, Walsh-Fluor, at 708-253-9772.
- The contractor will maintain garbage and recycling pickup.
- CTA will continue to work with Walsh-Fluor to identify additional opportunities to open the alley and/or provide access to garages/parking spaces when it is safe to do so.
- There will be noise while work is being performed, including:
 - General construction noise
 - Noise from excavation, pile driving, drilling, and pouring
 - Use of rivet removal equipment
 - Beeping from backup alarms on maintenance equipment and vehicles
