Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

INTERMITTENT DAILY ALLEY CLOSURES

Date(s): Monday, July 24 to Monday, August 21, 2023

Location: The alleys behind the following addresses will be impacted:

- 1002 – 1042 W. Roscoe Street
- 1015 – 1043 W. Newport Avenue
- 3400 – 3420 N. Sheffield Avenue
- 3401 – 3425 N. Seminary Avenue

Work Hours: 7am – 7pm; weekdays & Saturdays

Work Activity: Equipment Mobilization, Lead Abatement & Painting

Local Impact:

- Crews may periodically block access to garages/parking spaces in the alley behind W. Newport Avenue, N. Sheffield Avenue, N. Seminary Avenue, and W. Roscoe Street during equipment mobilization and waste pickup.
- **Vehicle access to enter/exit garages and parking spaces in the alley behind 1026-1042 W. Roscoe Street will be restricted at all times.**
- The alley behind 3401-3425 N. Seminary Avenue will be closed to thru traffic; access to garages/parking spaces will be maintained.
- The contractor will provide alternative parking for impacted residents.
- If you need further information about alternative parking, please contact the contractor, Walsh-Fluor, at 708-253-9772.
- The contractor will maintain access for garbage and recycling pickup.
- Crews will abate and paint the CTA structure, using the following tools, some of which will produce noise:
 - Containment covers
 - Portable generator and air compressor
 - Blast equipment & power tools
 - A specialized vacuum
 - Environmental & air monitoring equipment
- Crews will collect paint chips, debris and dust and dispose pursuant to Illinois EPA Guidelines for Hazardous Waste.
