We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

Date(s): **Wednesday, April 13 to Friday, April 15, 2022**

Location: The alleys behind the following addresses:

- 3400 – 3420 N. Sheffield Avenue
- 3401 – 3425 N. Seminary Avenue
- 1002 – 1042 W. Roscoe Street

Work Hours: **7am-5pm**

Work Activity: Potholing/Locating Underground Utilities

Local Impact:

- The garages/parking spaces may be intermittently blocked during stated work hours.
- Impacted residents can park in the alternative lot at the west end of the alley off of Seminary Avenue.
- Access to garages/parking spaces will be available at the end of each work day.
- The contractor will alternate work between the east and west ends of the alley.
- One end of the alley will remain open at all times, so that residents who are not impacted can access their garages/parking spaces.
- The contractor will maintain garbage and recycling pick up.
- There will be noise while work is being performed:
 - General construction noise
 - Beeping from backup alarms on vehicles
