Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

**Dates:** Friday October 13 to Monday, October 16, 2023

**Location:** Brown Line: CTA's Elevated Structure from Belmont Station to N. Seminary Avenue

**Work Hours:** 10pm-Friday to 4am-Monday (continuous around the clock work)

**Work Activity:** Bearing Replacement, Track Work & New Cable Relocation & Installation

**Local Impact:**

- There will be noise while work is being performed, **including nighttime noise**. Noise will include:
  - General construction noise
  - Running air compressors and generators
  - Use of pneumatic and gas/impact tools
  - Metal on metal material handling
  - Noise from rail equipment, crane and maintenance equipment
  - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
  - There will be light in the work area
  - Flagger horns
