Sheffield Avenue will be closed.</li> <li>The sidewalk on the east side of N. Sheffield Avenue will remain open.</li> <li>State and the east side of N. Sheffield Avenue will remain open.</li> <li>There will be traffic lane shifts with flagger assistance on W. Roscoe Street within the work zones during stated work hours.</li> <li>The parking lanes will be closed on both sides of W. Roscoe Street from N. Sheffield Avenue to N. Clark Street.</li> <li>The sidewalk on the north side of W. Roscoe Street will be closed.</li> <li>The sidewalk on the south side of W.
